

Responsibilities of the Professional Track Faculty Advisory Council and Procedure for Electing the Council.

PTK Faculty Council Responsibilities

The PTK Faculty Council meets with the Department Chair on matters of interest and concern to the Department. The three-member Council provides input to the Chair on matters of concern to PTK faculty. The Chair also consults the PTK Advisory Council.

Electing the Professional Track (PTK) Faculty Advisory Council

1. By May 1, the current PTK Faculty Advisory Council Chair shall announce the election of the PTK Faculty Advisory Council.
2. All PTK faculty are eligible to serve on the Council. Prior to the vote, the current Council Chair will recruit a slate of candidates for the election by soliciting nominees from all PTK faculty. Self-nominations are welcome.
3. All PTK faculty can vote for the Council members. The election will be conducted electronically and anonymously (e.g., via an online survey).
4. If more than three faculty are on the slate of candidates, the three candidates with the most votes will be elected to the Council to serve a one-year term (fall semester to spring semester of the following year).
